

# SMACNA'S BOARD LIAISON PROGRAM

SMACNA has instituted an association-wide communications program to increase the dialog between SMACNA chapters and the SMACNA leadership. This program is known as the Board of Directors Liaison Program.

Each SMACNA officer and director is assigned Board Liaison responsibility for a number of SMACNA chapters and state associations. The Board member is encouraged to establish regular communication with the chapters to enhance the exchange of information. Several key elements of the program include:



- identification of trends, problems and concerns;
- promotion of SMACNA programs and services; and
- implementation of SMACNA policies.

Chapters and state associations are asked to add their Board Liaison member to their regular mailing list, and issue regular invitations to them so they may attend chapter/state meetings to become familiar with the chapters and their members. Also, plan to set aside some time on the meeting agenda so your Board Liaison may address your group. If you have any specific topics you would like your Liaison to cover, please make note of that on the invitation request.

All invitations for Board Liaison visits should be submitted through SMACNA National. (See attached invitation form).

SMACNA has found the Board Liaison Program to be a great tool in establishing a meaningful relationship between SMACNA's leadership, local chapters and state associations. We encourage all of our chapters and state associations to contact their Board Liaison member and get to know them.

## Board Liaison Chapter/State Association Meeting Authorization Procedure

The following are guidelines for requesting Board Liaison members' participation at SMACNA chapter/state association meetings.

- 1. Submit a request for Board Liaison representative's participation at a chapter function to SMACNA National using the invitation form.

  Please allow adequate lead-time to coordinate your request. All requests are processed in the order they are received.
- 2. The Board member will be contacted by SMACNA to ascertain his/her availability to accept the invitation.
- 3. The chapter will be notified regarding the Board member's availability and approval of the participation under the Board Liaison Program.
  - In the event the Board Liaison member is unavailable to participate in the chapter function, SMACNA may assist the chapter in acquiring alternate SMACNA participation.
- 4. Routine travel expenses (transportation, room and board) incurred by the Board member for his/her participation in an approved function under the Board Liaison Program are paid by SMACNA.
- 5. Where appropriate, SMACNA staff will work with the Board member in preparing appropriate remarks for his/her participation in the chapter meeting.
- 6. While SMACNA does not encourage chapters to contact their Board Liaison member directly, on occasion it happens. In such cases, the chapter or Board member should contact SMACNA's Chief Executive Officer with the particulars of the request. The request will then be processed as if the visitation request form had been submitted.
